God has given you gifts to move mountains/challenges from your lives.

Matthew 17:20

And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

How do we use this scripture:

First: Unbelief is not recognizing that there is a *Spirit of GOD*. Therefore, you must believe and be aware of the *Spirit of GOD* within you.

For faith is given to us by GOD not man. The man that operates from the body (flesh) is a natural man, which will be faith deprived.

1 Corinthians 2:14

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

It is the *Spirit of GOD* within to which you must turn; you are limited in trying to resolve/remove the challenge (mountain) based on your physical ability (your body, your flesh).

John 6:63

It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

James 2:26

For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Secondly: Faith is a vision, an image, which one can imagine and has belief of it coming into visible manifestation.

Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Faith and imagination are spiritual gifts given to you by GOD. Imagination is very important. The gift of imagination allows you to visualize an ending, which is revealed as you work your faith. The vision of an ending is what you must continue to see, believe, and hope with the mind's eye as you work towards it. Yes, you must work your Faith.

James 2:20

But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?

James 2:17

Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

The definition of Energy is the ability to do work. Therefore, we must have a certain amount of energy/strength to access. Strength is a Gift of God. The Spirit of GOD within possesses strength.

2 Samuel 22:33

*God is my **strength** and power: and he maketh my way perfect.*

Exodus 15:2

Ephesians 3:16

*That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be **strengthened** with might by his **Spirit** in the inner man;*

One taps into strength by simply asking GOD in prayer. This strength gives you the energy to begin and continue the work.

Judges 16:28

And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord God, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.

1 Samuel 28:22

Now therefore, I pray thee, hearken thou also unto the voice of thine handmaid, and let me set a morsel of bread before thee; and eat, that thou mayest have strength, when thou goest on thy way.

Luke 22:32

But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren

Lastly: The more work one performs in working towards the vision, the more POWER one has to create. As you work through faith in GOD, the **Spirit of GOD** within you comes forth in a mighty way.

Matthew 21:21

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt

not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.
